The immediate goal of the Foundation is to raise funds and somehow offer the rapidly thinning WWII veterans who served in the Pacific especially those who defended and liberated the Philippines including the U.S. civilians who were in the Philippines during the war, a chance perhaps the last chance to visit the Philippines, a U.S. territory at that time, where the veterans fought and where so many of their comrades made the ultimate sacrifice.

It would be nice to extend this offer to the families, children, grandchildren and relatives of the WWII veterans and American civilians who were in the Phlippines especially to those who never had a chance to have a family of their own.

In the course ofour research, we found out that the Philippines has never held any VJ-Day or Liberation Day celebration whatsoever since the end of WWII. Yet my parents told me that had it not for the 11th Airborne Divison arriving at our hometown of Las Pinas, Rizal on Feb. 4, 1945 and surprised the Japanese, I wouldn't even be here. Strangely enough, the Philippines celebrate or commemorate the Fall of Bataan and the Fall of Corregidor, which from the Japanese perspective was victory in Bataan and victory in Corregidor. This is no longer acceptable.

We realize this is a major undertaking and getting as many WWII veterans to visit the places they've been in WWII is a race against time. The post-WWII generation on both sides of the Pacific, the children, grandchildren & descendants of those liberated by our WWII veterans must be made aware of the sacrifices made by the veterans in WWII. For those whose parents and grandparents were saved by American Liberators, must given a chance to express our thanks and show our appreciation. This is the urgent goal of the Foundation.
